From the Pool Canvas, you can manage and search for questions to add to a pool. You can edit the pool name and instructions, create or edit questions, and upload questions. You can also delete them or change the point values.

When you select pool questions for a test, links are created between the test and the pool questions. So, if you change the original question, the revised version of the question appears.

PLEASE NOTE: You cannot change a question type (example: from multiple choice to true and false). You must create a new question and delete the old question.

EDIT A QUESTION

To get started, go to the Control Panel, expand the Course Tools section and select Tests, Surveys, and Pools.

Tests
Tests are sets of questions that are graded to measure student performance. Once a test is created here, it must be deployed within a content folder before students can take the test. Test results are reviewed in the Grade Center. Note that some question types are not automatically graded.


Surveys
Surveys are not graded, and student responses are anonymous. They are useful for gathering data from students that is not used to evaluate student performance. Surveys must be deployed in a content folder for students to respond to the survey.

Pools
Pools are sets of questions that can be added to any Test or Survey. Pools are useful for storing questions and reusing them in more than one Test or Survey.

On the Pools page, access a pool's menu and select Edit. 

- You can sort through the pool questions by selecting a question type.




You can choose to display the questions as full text. -

Move your mouse over the Create Question button.




-You can choose the type of question that you'd like to add to your pool.

Find your question Pool that you'd like to move your question to and choose Edit to enter the pool canvas.


Move your mouse over the Find Questions button.
